Dear Parent/Guardian

As we approach the end of this academic year, I would like to express my thanks for your continued support in all we do at Mullavilly Primary School. This year it has been a joy to see our school beginning to resume normality post Covid-19 disruptions. The children have benefitted from the removal of class bubbles, the reintroduction of whole school assemblies and school trips. Our school fair and sports day were huge successes and it was wonderful to welcome all our parents and friends of Mullavilly to these events.

As of September 2022 we are moving to a composite class structure throughout Mullavilly. There will be five composite classes next year - Primary 1/2, Primary 2/3, Primary 3/4, Primary 5/6, and Primary 6/7. This does not mean that any pupils are being held back or moved forward. All children are taught in groups, which are formed by placing children who are at the same stage of development. Within all classes, as always, there will be children at different stages of development and of different abilities.
