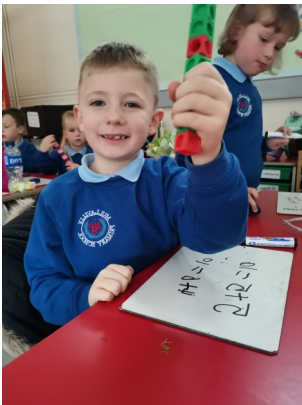


CONTACT INFORMATION

Please remember to check the Seesaw App for notifications from class teachers. We still require children to upload homework via Seesaw. Thank you.

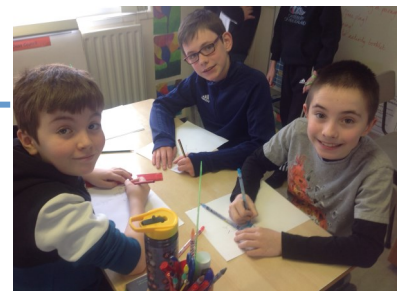


WELCOME BACK MRS RIDDLE!
